## TWO WOMEN'S AND GIRLS LEAGUES JOIN UP WITH ATTIS YPLN

We are delighted to confirm that two 'women's and girls' cricket leagues have joined up with Attis ECB Yorkshire Premier League North, and will compete under their own names as part of YPLN. Both the Scarborough & Ryedale Womens League and the North & East Yorkshire Womens League see the amalgamations as a positive move to help grow their leagues by using the YPLN administration resource along with potential access to help more clubs who are just starting to create womens & girls sections in the fastest growing area of cricket.

Scarborough & Ryedale WCL Chair Bev Nicholson said that "by using some of the YPLN administration services it allows us to focus on growing the women and girls game without being concerned about much of the paperwork that mostly goes unseen".

## YORK & DISTRICT JUNIOR CRICKET MERGE WITH YPLN

The York & District Junior Cricket Association have become part of YPLN in a move that will see resources shared between both organisations with the junior cricket group retaining its own name and management structure. YPLN General manager Rob Richtering said "the main aim is to centralise and share key areas like EDI, discipline and Safeguarding where we can".
