



ADMINISTRATION PENALTIES

Process

1. Merit table points will be automatically deducted for the transgressions listed below. At the end of the season clubs / teams amassing more than one hundred admin MT point deductions will be penalised at the rate of £1 per 1 MT point.
2. Where a financial penalty is issued If not paid within seven days a reminder will be issued.
3. If payment or action is still not forthcoming after a further seven days clubs will be required to attend a panel hearing and be liable for all expenses.

Panel Hearing

1. All clubs are entitled to appeal against any admin penalty imposed.
2. Contact the League Disciplinary Officer (administration@yplncricket.co.uk) with written reasons why you wish to appeal.
3. If a hearing is required, A standard non-refundable administration charge is mandatory to cover venue and panel members travel etc. Standard charges are £100 per hearing except in the case of any safeguarding hearing where the charge will be £150 as increased specialist panel members may be required, and up to £250 where time consuming investigations are required.

Notes

1. Tariffs are not exhaustive. Panels may increase or add additional penalties. This may include suspending a club, requesting a club applies for re-election to the league, and deduction of league points. This is not exhaustive.
2. Merit table deductions are made at the rate of 1 point deducted per £1 penalty.

Transgressions of the following offences will attract an immediate deduction of 25 Merit Table points (MT points) per offence. At the end of the season clubs who have accumulated over 100 MT points will be financially penalised at the rate of 1£ per MT point. This does not include points for disciplinary offences where financial penalties have already been levied.

Umpire Fees. Championship & divisions where league umpires are appointed. Failure to pay within timescale.

Umpire Fees. ECB Premier Division. Failure to pay by the end of the interval between innings.

Safeguarding Declaration. Failure to return by the date stipulated on the form.

AGM Voting Transgression – Failure to vote.

Cricket balls. Failure to pay within timescale.

Registration of Covers – teams below D1. Failure to inform league.

YCB affiliation Fees. Failure to pay within timescale.

Pre-season meetings - Non-attendance.

Extraordinary General Meetings. Non-attendance.

Annual Dinner Tickets. Failure to pay.

League Fees. Failure to pay within timescale.

Administrator Meetings – All Clubs. Failure to attend.

Club Details on Play-cricket - Failure to keep details up to date. Per offence.

Submission of Match Day Results - All Cup & league Competitions. Per match
Submission of Scorecards – Premier Division, Championship & Division One (s). Per match
Submission of Scorecards – Premier Division Cup Competitions & Hunters Premier Cup. Per match.
Submission of Scorecards – Division Two & Below. Per match
Submission of Scorecards – Readman & Conner Cup Competitions. Per match
Submission of Captains Marks – Failure to submit or late submission. ECB Premier Division & relevant cup competitions. Per match
Submission of Captains Marks - Failure to submit or late submission. Championship & First Divisions Only. Per match
Submission of Captains Marks - Failure to submit or late submission. Second Divisions and below. Per match.
Un-registered Players – All cup competitions except ECB Premier Division related.
Failure to ‘Live Score’ – ECB Premier Division per match.
Returning League Trophies – Failure to return by 10th August. Recovery cost will be charged.
Failure to provide a scorer – Premier Division, Championship & Division One (s). Per match

Transgressions of the following offences will attract an immediate deduction of 50 Merit Table points (MT points) per offence. At the end of the season clubs who have accumulated over 100 MT points will be financially penalised at the rate of 1£ per MT point. This does not include points for disciplinary offences where financial penalties have already been levied.

Notification of Club Safeguarding Officer – Failure to do so.
Submission of Scorecards – ECB Premier Division by 9.30 pm on match day.
Failure to fulfil or complete a Fixture - (other than weather related) + 10 League points awarded to the opposition.
Failure to fulfil or complete a Cup Tie - (other than weather related) Suspended from following years competition.
Failure to provide an umpire –Division One (s). Per match

Transgressions of the following offences will attract an immediate deduction of 100 Merit Table points (MT points) per offence. At the end of the season clubs who have accumulated over 100 MT points will be financially penalised at the rate of 1£ per MT point. This does not include points for disciplinary offences where financial penalties have already been levied.

Un-registered Players – ECB Premier Division only.
Team Strengthening - All Divisions. All league points gained in match plus a further 10 deducted. Opposition awarded winning points. Per match.
Ineligible player - All Divisions. All league points gained in match plus a further 10 deducted. Opposition awarded winning points.
Ineligible player – Cup& T20 - match is awarded to the opposition and team suspended from following years competition.

Penalties for the following transgressions will be decided at a panel hearing. Clubs requested to attend a panel hearing will be charged a non-refundable admin fee of £100, plus any expenses incurred by panel members.

Non-payment of Admin Penalty – All clubs.
ECB Child Protection Policy – Failure to adhere to.
DBS Checks – Failure to have required individuals checked.
Failure to provide Match Teas -
Failure to use Covers – Where registered.

If the away team concedes, the home team can claim £100 per League match or £25 per Cup tie. All applicable only if the match is conceded after 6pm on the previous day. Claimants should contact the opposition directly. League involvement should only be when there is an issue</p>
