Un-registered Players	Y&DSDL Divisions and Cups	All players (including loan players) must be correctly registered online via the League play-cricket website. The League will accept the registration of players after a match has been played only if the player has never played for another club (typically the player would be a last-minute replacement). This must be completed within 48 hours. The onus and responsibility for ensuring that all players are fully eligible rests totally with each individual club. An offence is quantified as each player as opposed to each scorecard.			
	ECB Premier League	Rule 15 v - A team playing an unregistered player or a player subsequently found to be unqualified, shall be deducted all points gained in the games played by the said player, and will be subject to a financial penalty as per the League schedule of penalties. 	ECB Premier League Cup Competitions	A team found to have an un-registered player will be expelled from the relevant year's competition.			Penalties Per Transgression: Removal from competition plus financial penalty of £50.
Ineligible player	ECB Premier League and Cup Competitions	A team found to be playing an ineligible player shall be deducted all points gained in the games played by the said player, with the match(es) being awarded to the opposition. In the event of the match being a cup tie the match will be awarded to the opposition.	Rob Smith & Steve Berry	Penalties Per Transgression Per Match: Deduction of 10 league Points & 10 point match win awarded to the opposition.	
	Y&DSDL Divisions and Cups	A club which breaches the registration rules relating to England qualified players or includes an incorrectly transferred player will suffer a deduction of 30 points, and the game will be awarded to the opposition, save that the League may inflict reduced penalties where the club successfully proves that a genuine error had occurred. A club found to have played an illegal non-England qualified player will be deducted 30 points for every game in which the player appeared illegally.		Per Transgression: Deduction of Thirty League points, £50 fixed penalty, match awarded to the opposition.	
Ineligible non-England qualified player	ECB Premier League and Cup Competitions	Any player adjudged by the ECB, UK Visas & Immigration, the Home Office, or other official body to be on an incorrect visa or in the UK illegally will be deemed to be ineligible and 10 League points will be deducted for each match played in by the individual(s) concerned. League points will be deducted for the current season unless official notification is received after 1st November, in which case the league points will be deducted from the following season. Team Strengthening	Y&DSDL Divisions and Cups	No club shall strengthen its second, or lower, team, at any stage in the season, with a regular first team player without just reason. Clubs should seek this approval whenever any doubt exists. This penalty will apply per match, and not per player, and is regardless of the result. Match Teas	ECB Premier League and Cup Competitions	The home team will provide at no cost 13 teas for the visiting side plus two for the umpires. One drinks interval shall be taken in each innings; this may be dispensed with or added to only by agreement of both captains.

	Y&DSCL Divisions and Cups	Teams in Premier & First Divisions shall use an official League-approved new ball for each innings. Teams in Division Two and below need not use a new ball but must use a Grade 'A' ball of British manufacture.	Phil Robshaw	
Registration of Covers	Y&DSCL Divisions and Cups	Teams in the Premier & First Divisions must have & use covers. Disciplinary Rules	All Clubs	All clubs must possess a copy of club specific disciplinary rules. These must be sent immediately to the appointed Case Manager in the event of a disciplinary incident without the league having to request them.	Case Manager where applicable	
Failure to fulfil a Fixture	ECB Premier League & Y&DSCL Divisions and all Cup Competitions	In the event of a fixture not being fulfilled for reasons other than weather related clubs will be required to submit a written explanation which may result in a panel hearing. Opposition clubs may submit reasonable compensation claims not exceeding £250 to be decided at the next administration panel hearing.	Phil Robshaw	
		<u>Compensation</u> If the home team concedes, the away team can claim £25 per League match or £25 per Cup tie. If the away team concedes, the home team can claim £100 per League match or £25 per Cup tie. All applicable only if the match is conceded after 6pm on the previous day. Claimants should contact the opposition directly. League involvement should only be when there is an issue. League Trophies	ECB Premier League & Y&DSCL Divisions and all Cup Competitions	Any club or individual winning a League trophy is responsible for its safekeeping, and will be required to compensate for any loss or damage. Winners must arrange adequate insurance cover and must have the trophy appropriately engraved, in order to be available for presentation to the new winners. It is <u>not</u> the League's responsibility to remind clubs to return trophies by the deadline date of 10th August. Clubs who lose trophies will be expected to fund a replacement on a 'like for like basis'.	Phil Robshaw	Per Transgression: Failure to return by the required date - financial penalty of £25 plus recovery costs. Where a trophy is returned without being properly engraved, the League shall make a charge of £25 to cover cost of engraving and associated costs.
Umpire Fees	Y&DSCL Divisions	This is applicable to clubs with teams playing in divisions officiated by League allocated panel umpires. The League will issue invoices to clubs, but ultimately it is the individual club's responsibility to ensure that fees are paid on time.	David Farmer	Non-Compliance Procedure & Penalties Formal reminder issued. If payment or action is not forthcoming 14 days after reminder a £20 fixed penalty will be issued. If payment or action is still not forthcoming after a further 14 days clubs will be required to attend a panel hearing and be liable for all expenses.
Annual Dinner	All Clubs	Rule 38. All member clubs are required to purchase a minimum of two tickets for the Annual Dinner. Clubs will be invoiced prior to the start of the season when YCB affiliation fees are collected.

DBS Checks		Captains, umpires and scorers participating on a regular basis must be DBS checked prior to the start of the season, or when appointed. It is a club's responsibility to ensure that all relevant personnel are fully compliant.		
ECB Child Protection Policy		Clubs must comply with the ECB Child Protection Policy requirements relating to junior players. It is a club's responsibility to ensure that ECB Safeguarding policies are adhered to at all times.		
Non-payment of Admin Penalty	YLN, YDSCL and Conference	Where a financial Penalty has been imposed but remains unpaid within the timescale prescribed, the Club, Player or Participant shall be subject to Disciplinary action under level four.	Phil Robshaw	Disciplinary Hearing

Notes

1	The above tariff is not exhaustive.
2	Where transgressions require a hearing (either in the first instance or by appeal) there will be a mandatory non-refundable administration charge of £50.
3	Penalties at panel hearings may include League point deductions, additional financial penalties, and suspension.
4	For Y&DSCL financial penalties merit table deductions are made at 1 point per £2 financial penalty.
5	Administration panels have the authority to impose financial and league point penalties. They may also suspend a club.
