

## Submission of Captains' Reports - Championship & below (Updated April 2023)


Team Captains (or their representative) are required to submit reports at the end of each match in the Championship and below where play has been possible.

In matches covered by the Neutral Umpires' Panel, both captains need to submit a report on both umpires and the away captain has to submit a Ground Report.

In the First Divisions and below, the home captain does not have to submit a report and the away captain only needs to submit a Ground Report.

#### Captains need to be registered on Play Cricket to be able to find the reports that they need to complete.

When you log in to your club's website clicking on Account will give you a drop-down list as shown



If you click on **Team Reports** it will take you to a page which looks like one of the following, depending whether you are a Home captain or an Away captain and which Division you are in:
