



# YPLN Privacy Policy

(Updated March 2020)

The Yorkshire Premier League North (“The League”) is fully committed to protecting the rights and privacy of its member clubs, their members, the Umpires’ Panel and members of its own Management Board and Committees, as well as any other stakeholder involved in the day to day business of the League.

This Privacy Policy sets out the basis on which any personal data that The League collects from you, or that you provide to The League, will be processed. It also sets out your privacy rights and how the law protects you. Please read the following carefully to understand The League’s views and practices regarding your personal data and how it will be treated by The League. When you provide information by which you can be identified, it will, only, be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

The League may change this policy from time to time by updating this page.

## What does The League collect?

- Name, title, date of birth and gender
- Email address
- Contact telephone number(s)
- Other information relevant to participation in The League’s activities

## What does The League do with the information it collects?

- Send/receive information pertaining to The League’s activities
- Improve communications between YPLN and its stakeholders
- Maintains YPLN records

## How does The League use the information provided?

All personal information that The League obtains about you and/or any other person whose details you provide will be recorded, used and protected by The League in accordance with current data protection legislation and this Privacy Policy.

The League will, primarily, use the personal information:

- For record keeping purposes
- For registration and general administration (including verification, vetting and security checking)
- To ensure appropriate communications are distributed/received between The League, its member clubs and other stakeholders

## Disclosing your personal information

Some limited information may be shared with other stakeholders in Cricket, such as ECB, County Cricket Boards and other competition organisers so they can maintain appropriate records and assist The League in administering and organising cricket fixtures.

## **Children**

The League does not knowingly collect data relating to children without the knowledge of their parent or guardian.

## **Information about other people**

If you provide information about any other person other than yourself, you must ensure that they understand how their information will be used and that you are authorised to disclose it to The League, and to consent to its use on their behalf, before doing so.

## **Data Security**

The League is committed to ensuring that your information is secure. To prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, The League has suitable procedures in place to safeguard and secure the information collected. In addition, The League limits access to your personal data to those parties who have a business need to know. They will only process your personal data on the instructions of the Data Controller and they are subject to a duty of confidentiality.

Where Play-cricket has given you a password which enables you to access a certain area of the website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential and you are requested not to share this password with anyone. Once The League has received your information, strict procedures and security features will be used to prevent unauthorised access. Procedures have been put in place to deal with any suspected personal data breach and The League will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where it is legally required to do so.

## **Data Retention**

The League will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes that it was collected, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting or reporting requirements. To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, The League considers the amount, nature and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorised use or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which your personal data is processed by The League, whether those purposes can be achieved by other means and the applicable legal requirements.

## **Cookies**

The League does not use cookies on its website.

## **Links to Other Websites**

The League website contains links to other websites of interest. However, once you have used these links to leave the site, you should note that The League does not have any control over that other website. Therefore, The League is not responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement. When you leave The League website, you are encouraged to read the privacy notice of every website that you visit.

## **What rights do you have?**

You have the right to ask The League for a copy of your personal data, to correct, delete or restrict (stop any active) processing of your personal data. In addition, you can object to the processing of your personal data in some circumstances. These rights may be limited, for example, if fulfilling your request would reveal personal data about another person, or if you ask to delete information which The League is required by law to retain or have compelling legitimate interests in retaining.

The League does not sell, give, distribute, or lease your personal information to commercial organisations.
